Transportation Development Act Claims for Yolo and Yuba Counties

Issue: The Transportation Development Act provides that cities, counties, and transit operators are eligible to receive certain funds for transportation purposes and street and road projects. The funds are made available from sales tax receipts. Transportation Development Act claims have been submitted by Yolo and Yuba Counties.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the SACOG Board of Directors approve by resolution the Yolo and Yuba County Transportation Development Act claims:

Yolo County in the amount of \$987,404	Resolution No. 45 – 2005
Yuba County in the amount of \$424,964	Resolution No. 46 – 2005

These funds will be used for various purposes as authorized by law in the amounts to be shown on the resolution. These claims have been reviewed by staff and found to be in compliance with the Transportation Development Act. These claims are also found to be consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the appropriate Short Range Transit Plans, and appropriate unmet transit needs finding resolutions for Yolo and Yuba Counties that were adopted by the SACOG Board in July.
