RESOLUTION NO. 58 - 2006

**APPROVING THE CITY OF ISLETON'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM
FOR 2006/2007 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,646**

WHEREAS, the City of Isleton has submitted a claim under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2006/2007 in the amount of \$36,646, and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 28-2006 on July 20, 2006, finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Isleton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2006/07 (\$36,646), and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Isleton in proportion to funds received from the State.
