Transportation Development Act Claims: City of Live Oak, City of Wheatland and Sacramento Regional Transit District

Issue: The Transportation Development Act provides that cities, counties, and transit operators are eligible to receive certain funds for transportation purposes and street and road projects. The funds are made available from sales tax receipts. The Cities of Live Oak and Wheatland and the Sacramento Regional Transit District have filed Transportation Development Act claims.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board approve by resolution the Transportation Development Act claims for the Cities of Live Oak, Wheatland and the Sacramento Regional Transit District:

These funds will be used for various purposes as authorized by law in the amounts to be shown on the resolutions. These claims have been reviewed by staff and found to be in compliance with the Transportation Development Act. These claims are also found to be consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the appropriate Short Range Transit Plans, and appropriate unmet transit needs finding resolution for each of the jurisdictions for the year of the claim that were adopted by the SACOG Board in July 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006. Current Board policy calls for routine Transportation Development Act allocations to cities and counties to come directly to the Board without review by a committee.

**APPROVING THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT'S
AMENDED TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FY 2006/07
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,553,881**

WHEREAS, the SRTD has submitted a request for additional State Transit Assistance Funds (STA) for FY 2006/07 in the amount of \$7,553,881, which added to the previously approved amount of \$7,879,811 provides a total STA amount of \$15,433,692 and these funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, such claim is consistent with the Transportation Development Act, with Guidelines adopted by the Board and with approved revised apportionments for FY 2006/07, and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 30-2006 on July 20, 2006, finding that there are unmet transit needs in the Sacramento Regional Transit District that are reasonable to meet, and

WHEREAS, the RT Claim and support documentation provides sufficient information to support the immediate release of \$3,974,933 of requested capital funds, as those funds become available from the state, and

WHEREAS, the RT staff will, when such information becomes available, provide additional information to support release of the \$3,503,948 of requested operating funds and \$75,000 of requested capital funds and will provide that information to SACOG staff for review and assessment for adequacy to support the release of the additional STA funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby makes the following findings in accordance with Subchapter 2.5, Article 5, Section 6754 of the Transportation Development Act:

1. SRTD's proposed expenditures are in conformity with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable SRTD to meet the fare revenue requirements of the Public Utilities Code.
3. SRTD is making full use of federal funds available under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.
4. The sum of SRTD's allocations from the State Transit Assistance Fund and from the Local Transportation Fund does not exceed the amount the claimant is eligible to receive during the fiscal year.
5. Priority consideration has been given to claims to offset reductions in federal operating assistance and the unanticipated increase in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services, and to meet high priority areawide public transportation needs.
6. SRTD has made a reasonable effort to implement the productivity improvements recommended pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99244.
7. SRTD is not precluded by any contract entered into on or after June 28, 1979, from employing part-time drivers or from contracting with common carriers of persons operating under a franchise or license.
8. SRTD has submitted the required certification by the Department of the California Highway Patrol verifying that the operator is in compliance with Section 1808.1 of the Vehicle Code.
9. The operator is in compliance with the eligibility requirements of Public Utilities Code Section 99314.6 or 99314.7 and will use STA funds for operating purposes only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for additional State Transit Assistance Funds for FY 2006/07 in the amount of \$7,553,881 which added to the previously approved amount of \$7,879,811 provides total approved STA funds up to the full amount of \$15,433,692, and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the Sacramento Regional Transit District in proportion to funds received from the State. The SACOG Board also authorizes SACOG staff to release the full amount of STA funds upon the submission of such additional data by RT as is necessary to support the full release of the FY 2006/07 funds.

WHEREAS, the City of Wheatland has submitted a claim under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2001/02 in the amount of \$28,406, FY 2002/03 in the amount of \$43,193, FY 2003/04 in the amount of \$39,635, FY 2004/05 in the amount of \$37,706, FY 2005/06 in the amount of \$63,290, FY 2006/07 in the amount of \$84,129 including \$7,142 in planning funds over that same period, for a total request of \$303,501; and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board adopted resolutions in FY's 2001/2002 through 2006/2007 that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Wheatland.

WHEREAS, the City of Wheatland and SACOG will continue to work with Yuba-Sutter Transit to develop a mechanism whereby the City of Wheatland's STA funds can be used to support and improve City transit services.

WHEREAS, the City of Wheatland will contribute \$203 for FY 2005/2006 and \$85 for FY 2006/2007 from the general fund to maintain a fare revenue to operating expenses ratio of 10%.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2001/02 in the amount of \$28,406, FY 2002/03 in the amount of \$43,193, FY 2003/04 in the amount of \$39,635, FY 2004/05 in the amount of \$37,706, FY 2005/06 in the amount of \$63,290, FY 2006/07 in the amount of \$84,129 including \$7,142 in planning funds for a total request of \$303,501.
