Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan Amendment

Funding for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Funding Program is anticipated to be available in fall 2007. According to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Funding Program Guidelines approved by the Board in September 2005, eligible projects will come from the “High Priority” project list included in the Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan. Projects in El Dorado and Placer Counties will be funded separately according to their written agreements with SACOG. To be sure the Regional Master Plan contains the most current and accurate information, the attached project amendments are proposed.

Attachment A is the Amended Project List. Revisions are in ~~strikeout~~ or bold and highlighted. Where new projects have been added, text is in bold. Where projects have been deleted, text is in ~~strikeout~~. Where projects have been revised, portions of text are in ~~strikeout~~ and replaced with bold text. In some cases, single projects have been replaced with multiple smaller projects, such as on page 1, Elk Grove Creek, Laguna Boulevard to Waterman Road, has been replaced with six smaller segments. The corresponding maps will also be amended to reflect changes to the project list and are available upon request.

This amendment will be released for 30-day public review in May. Staff will provide written response to comments and will come back to the Board in July for approval.
