**ADOPTING THE AMENDED REGIONAL BICYCLE, PEDESTRIAN, AND TRAILS
MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) has prepared the Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan as mandated in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan lists projects within the counties of Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba that are eligible for funding under the Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Funding Program.

WHEREAS, the Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan was developed with input and recommendations from cities, counties, public agencies, advocates, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the SACOG Board of Directors adopted the Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan in November, 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sacramento Area Council of Governments adopts the Amended Regional Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan.
