RESOLUTION NO. 55 – 2007

**APPROVING SACOG PUBLIC TRANSIT AND HUMAN SERVICES
TRANSPORTATION COORDINATED PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Regional Transportation Planning Agency responsible for transportation planning in the Sacramento region; and

WHEREAS, SACOG is responsible for preparing and adopting the Metropolitan Transportation Plan and the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, SACOG is the designated recipient for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Job Access and Reverse Commute program (Section 5316) and New Freedom program (Section 5317) fund in the Sacramento Urbanized Area, as designated by the Census 2000 with all 5316 and 5317 projects to come from a locally developed coordinated public transit/human services transportation plan; and

WHEREAS, SACOG has reviewed and followed the March 23, 2006, September 6, 2006 and March 29, 2007 Federal Register requirements reflecting the FTA elements of a coordinated plan; and

WHEREAS, SACOG has completed the SACOG Public Transit and Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan for the six counties it serves including the rural, small urbanized and large urbanized areas; and

WHEREAS, SACOG will submit the SACOG Public Transit and Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan to the appropriate State of California and U.S. Federal agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that SACOG certifies that:

1. SACOG has completed the regional SACOG Public Transit and Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan as required by the *Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient, Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users* (SAFETEA-LU).

2. Projects funded will be generally based on the SACOG Public Transit and Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan.
3. Projects funded will be included in the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).
4. The projects funded will be consistent with SACOG's adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
