



**SACRAMENTO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS**

**RESOLUTION NO. 45 - 2007**

**APPROVING THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM  
FOR FY 2007/08 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,917,509**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove has submitted in accordance with the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, a request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2007/08 in the amount of \$4,582,625, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove has submitted a request for State Transit Assistance Funds for FY 2007/08 in the amount of \$334,884 and such funds will be used as follows:

**WHEREAS**, such claim is consistent with the Transportation Development Act, with Guidelines adopted by the Board and with approved apportionments for FY 2007/08, and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that these funds are being used to respond to a transportation need that would not otherwise be met within the community, are coordinated with the area's transit operators, provide for on-going contracts with the Sacramento Regional Transit District to provide a consistent level of service to that previously provided, and allow the City of Elk Grove to continue and improve the transportation services traditionally provided by the Sacramento Regional Transit District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board adopted Resolution No. 28-2007 on July 19, 2007, finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Elk Grove.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board hereby makes the following findings in accordance with Subchapter 2.5, Article 5, Section 6754 of the Transportation Development Act:

1. The City of Elk Grove's proposed expenditures are in conformity with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable the City of Elk Grove to meet the fare revenue requirements of the Public Utilities Code.
3. The City of Elk Grove is making full use of federal funds available under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.
4. The sum of City of Elk Grove's allocations from the State Transit Assistance Fund and from the Local Transportation Fund does not exceed the amount the claimant is eligible to receive during the fiscal year.
5. Priority consideration has been given to claims to offset reductions in federal operating assistance and the unanticipated increase in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services, and to meet high priority areawide public transportation needs.
6. The City of Elk Grove as a new operator was not subject to the productivity improvements recommended pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99244.
7. The City of Elk Grove is not precluded by any contract entered into on or after June 28, 1979, from employing part-time drivers or from contracting with common carriers of persons operating under a franchise or license.
8. The City of Elk Grove has submitted the required certification by the Department of the California Highway Patrol verifying that the operator is in compliance with Section 1808.1 of the Vehicle Code.
9. The operator is in compliance with the eligibility requirements of Public Utilities Code Section 99314.6 or 99314.7 and will use STA funds for operating purposes only.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2007/08 in the amount of \$4,582,625 and FY 2007/08 STA funds in the amount of \$334,884, in the total amount of \$4,917,509 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Elk Grove in proportion to funds received from the State and authorizes the transmittal of allocation instructions to the Sacramento County auditor consistent with the approved claim.
