RESOLUTION NO. 46 - 2007

**APPROVING THE CITY OF GALT'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT
CLAIM FOR FY 2006/07 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,171,121**

WHEREAS, the City of Galt has submitted a claim under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2006/07 in the amount of \$973,370; and

WHEREAS, the City of Galt has submitted a request for State Transit Assistance Funds for FY2006/07 in the amount of \$197,751, and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, such claim is consistent with the Transportation Development Act, with Guidelines adopted by the SACOG Board of Directors and with approved apportionments through FY 2006/07, and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 27-2006 on July 20, 2006 finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Galt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby makes the following findings in accordance with Subchapter 2.5, Article 4, Section 6754:

1. The City of Galt's proposed expenditures are in conformance with the adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan;
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable the City of Galt to meet the fare revenue requirements of the Public Utilities Code as they apply;

3. The City of Galt is making full use of federal funds available under the Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended;
4. The amount of this claim does not exceed the amount the City of Galt is eligible to receive during this fiscal year;
5. Priority consideration has been given to this claim because its purpose is to offset reductions in federal operating assistance and the unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services, and to meet high priority areawide public transportation needs;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2006/07 (\$973,370) and State Transit Assistance funds for FY 2006/07 (\$197,751), in the total amount of \$1,171,121 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Galt in proportion to funds received from the State, and authorizes the transmittal of allocation instructions to the Sacramento County auditor consistent with the appeal claim.
