RESOLUTION NO. 48 - 2007

**APPROVING THE COUNTY OF YUBA'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM
FOR FY 2007/2008 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,139,209**

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba has submitted a claim under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2007/2008 Local Transportation Funds in the amount of \$1,139,209 and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, such claim is consistent with State Law, with Guidelines adopted by the Board and with approved apportionments for FY 2007/2008; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 42-2007 on July 19, 2007 finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the County of Yuba; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba has provided the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority with sufficient funds (\$583,363) to provide transit services within the County for FY 2007/2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2007/2008 in the total amount of \$1,139,209 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the County of Yuba in proportion to funds received from the State.
