

AMENDMENT NO. 3
AGREEMENT FOR CALL BOX SYSTEM MAINTENANCE BETWEEN CAPITOL
VALLEY REGIONAL SERVICE AUTHORITY FOR FREEWAYS AND
EXPRESSWAYS, AND COMARCO WIRELESS TECHNOLOGIES

This Amendment No. 3 to the January 20, 2000, Agreement for Call Box System Maintenance (“Agreement”) between the Capitol Valley Regional Service Authority for Freeways and Expressways (“CVRS”) and Comarco Wireless Technologies (“Contractor”) is entered into effective July 19, 2007.

WHEREAS, CVRS and Contractor wish to amend the Agreement as it relates to level of service, compensation, and time of completion for the “Comarco” call boxes. Once a call box is converted to the digital/TTY call box it becomes a “Republic” call box.

NOW, THEREFORE, CVRS and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Contractor will reduce the monthly maintenance rate from \$30.27 to \$27.14 for July, August, and September 2007 for remaining Comarco call boxes. In exchange, Contractor will discontinue bi-annual field visits (preventative maintenance) immediately.
2. CVRS will pay Contractor a fixed amount of \$32,000 for October 2007 and \$32,000 for November 2007 for providing corrective maintenance and knockdown maintenance to the remaining Comarco call boxes.
3. On November 30th 2007 all Contractor services end except for daily call box monitoring.
4. For sixty days beginning December 1, 2007, Contractor will continue to provide daily monitoring services and send reports to CVRS. Any necessary corrective and knockdown maintenance (for the remaining Comarco call boxes) will be handled by CVRS.
5. Contractor will charge CVRS for the monthly phone costs (for the daily monitoring) and for any one-time set up charges to move their maintenance and computer equipment to their other location.
5. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
