Transportation Development Act Claim for the City of Folsom

Issue: The Transportation Development Act provides that cities, counties, and transit operators are eligible to receive certain funds for transportation purposes and street and road projects. The funds are made available from sales tax receipts. The City of Folsom has filed their Transportation Development Act claim.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board approve by resolution the Transportation Development Act claim for the City of Folsom.

1. City of Folsom in the amount of \$2,732,566 Resolution No. 5 – 2008

Discussion: These funds will be used for various purposes as authorized by law in the amounts to be shown on the resolution. The claim has been reviewed by staff and found to be in compliance with the Transportation Development Act. The claim is also consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the appropriate City of Folsom Short Range Transit Plan, and appropriate FY 2007-08 unmet transit needs finding resolutions for the City of Folsom. Current Board policy calls for routine Transportation Development Act allocations to cities and counties to come directly to the Board without review by a committee.

RESOLUTION NO. 5 – 2008

**APPROVING THE CITY OF FOLSOM TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT
ACT CLAIM FOR FY 2007/2008 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,732,566**

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom has submitted a request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2007/2008 in the amount of \$2,432,092, and

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom has submitted a request for State Transit Assistance Funds for FY 2007/2008 in the amount of \$300,474, and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, the SACOG Board adopted Resolution No. 27-2007 on July 19, 2007 finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Folsom;

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom will use \$929,000 of previously claimed FY 2006/07 Local Transportation Funds for Folsom Stage Line Operations, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby makes the following findings in accordance with Subchapter 2.5, Article 5, Section 6754:

1. The City of Folsom's proposed expenditures are in conformity with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan.
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable the City of Folsom to meet the fare revenue requirements of the Public Utilities Code.
3. The City of Folsom is making full use of federal funds available under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.
4. The sum of the City of Folsom's allocations from the State Transit Assistance fund and from the Local Transportation Fund does not exceed the amount the claimant is eligible to receive during the fiscal year.
5. Priority consideration has been given to claims to offset reductions in federal operating assistance and the unanticipated increase in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services, and to meet high priority area wide public transportation needs.
6. The City of Folsom has made a reasonable effort to implement the productivity improvements recommended pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99244, as identified in the triennial performance audit.
7. The City of Folsom is not precluded by any contract entered into on or after June 28, 1979, from employing part-time drivers or from contracting with common carriers of persons operating under a franchise or license.
8. The City of Folsom has submitted the required certification by the Department of the California Highway Patrol verifying that the operator is in compliance with Section 1808.1 of the Vehicle Code.
9. The City of Folsom is not in compliance with the eligibility requirements of Public Utilities Code Section 99314.6 and will use STA funds for capital purposes only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the SACOG Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2007/2008 in the amount of \$2,432,092, and for State Transit Assistance Funds for FY 2007/2008 in the amount of \$300,474 for a total claim amount of \$2,732,566 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Folsom in proportion to funds received from the State.
