Approve Transportation Development Act Claims for the City of Galt, City of Davis, and Sacramento Regional Transit District

Issue: The Transportation Development Act provides that cities, counties, and transit operators are eligible to receive certain funds for transportation purposes and street and road projects. The funds are made available from sales tax receipts. The City of Galt has filed its FY 2009-10 Transportation Development Act Claim and its FY 2008-09 Amended Transportation Development Act Claim, the Sacramento Regional Transit has an Amended FY 2009-10 Transportation Development Act Claim, and the City of Davis has filed an Amended FY 2008-2009 Transportation Development Act Claim.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board approve by resolution the FY 2008-09 and FY 2009-10 Transportation Development Act claims for the City of Galt, the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SRTD), and the City of Davis.

Current Board policy calls for routine Transportation Development Act allocations to cities and counties to come directly to the Board without review by a committee.

WHEREAS, the City of Galt has submitted an amended claim for Local Transportation Funds under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$790,266 and;

WHEREAS, the City of Galt has submitted an amended claim for State Transit Assistance under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$51,085, and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, such claim is consistent with State Law, with Guidelines adopted by the Board and with approved apportionments for FY 2008-09; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 11 - 2008 on March 20, 2008, finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the City of Galt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby makes the following findings in accordance with Subchapter 2.5, Article 5, Section 6754 of the Transportation Development Act:

1. The City of Galt's proposed expenditures are in conformity with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable the City of Galt to meet the fare revenue requirements of the Public Utilities Code.
3. The City of Galt is making full use of federal funds available under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.
4. The sum of City of Galt's allocations from the State Transit Assistance Fund and from the Local Transportation Fund does not exceed the amount the claimant is eligible to receive during the fiscal year.
5. Priority consideration has been given to claims to offset reductions in federal operating assistance and the unanticipated increase in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services, and to meet high priority area wide public transportation needs.
6. The City of Galt has made a reasonable effort to implement the productivity improvements recommended pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99244.
7. The City of Galt is not precluded by any contract entered into on or after June 28, 1979, from employing part-time drivers or from contracting with common carriers of persons operating under a franchise or license.
8. The City of Galt has submitted the required certification by the Department of the California Highway Patrol verifying that the operator is in compliance with Section 1808.1 of the Vehicle Code.
9. The operator is in compliance with the eligibility requirements of Public Utilities Code Section 99314.6 or 99314.7 and will use STA funds for operating purposes only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$790,266 and for State Transit Assistance funds for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$51,085, for a total claim amount of \$841,351, and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Galt in proportion to funds received from the State.

7. The City of Davis is not precluded by any contract entered into on or after June 28, 1979, from employing part-time drivers or from contracting with common carriers of persons operating under a franchise or license.
8. The contractor, Yolo County Transportation District, has submitted the certification required by the Department of the California Highway Patrol verifying that the operator is in compliance with Section 1801.1 of the Vehicle Code.
9. The City of Davis is in compliance with the eligibility requirements of Public Utilities Code Section 99314.6.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$2,612,007, for Local Transportation Funds previously claimed in FY 2007-2008 for \$341,392, for State Transit Assistance funds for FY 2007-08 in the amount of \$163,317 and for State Transit Assistance funds for FY 2008-09 in the amount of \$192,816 for a total claim in the amount of \$3,309,532 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the City of Davis in proportion to funds received from the State.
