## Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee

October 15, 2009

### Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Funding Program

**Issue:** SACOG's Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Funding Program (Funding Program) seeks to help fund capital and non-capital bicycle and pedestrian projects throughout Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba counties through a competitive process.

**Recommendation:** None; this is for information only.

**Discussion:** Project applications are due to SACOG at the close of business on Friday, October 23. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Working Group will begin reviewing applications on Monday, October 26, and will make final recommendations by early November. At the last Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee meeting, the committee selected four staff members (Ken Gaines, Terry Preston, Walt Seifert, and Greta Vohlers) to serve on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Working Group. The other Working Group members are from the Regional Planning Partnership, Transit Coordinating Committee, Planner's Committee, and the Transportation Demand Management Committee. (See attachment.)

Next steps:

- November 17 SACOG will conduct a second workshop to discuss draft programming recommendations for the Funding Programs (Bicycle & Pedestrian, Community Design, and Local & Regional).
- December 17 The Board will release programming recommendations. At this meeting, the Board will also hold a public hearing for any interested and concerned parties to address the proposed recommendations.
- January 21 The Board will vote on the programming recommendations in order to meet statutory deadlines with the California Transportation Commission.
