**APPROVING THE TRANSIT SYSTEM SAFETY, SECURITY, AND DISASTER
RESPONSE ACCOUNT FUNDING REQUEST FOR FY 2009-10
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,398,859**

WHEREAS, Proposition 1B Transportation Bond Program has made funds available under the Transit System Safety, Security and Disaster Response Account (TSS); and

WHEREAS, SACOG staff has conducted the project selection process in accordance with the *Guidelines and Evaluation Form* approved by the Board on April 10, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the SACOG Transportation Committee has reviewed the proposed projects and recommended that SACOG support and submit Project Investment Justifications (applications) for these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Regional Transit District has applied for \$888,843 of FY 2009-10 TSS funds for Enhancement of Emergency Power Generation Operations Capability; and Hardening of Bus Lots; and

WHEREAS, Paratransit, Inc has applied for \$200,000 of FY 2009-10 TSS funds for Onboard Digital Surveillance System; and Facility Security Enhancement; and

WHEREAS, Yuba-Sutter Transit has applied for \$131,044 of FY 2009-10 TSS funds for Facility Safety and Security Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Transportation District has applied for \$104,060 of FY 2009-10 TSS funds for Facility Safety and Security Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the SACOG Board of Directors hereby approves the distribution of TSS funds to the projects and in the amounts described above and, authorizes the Executive Director to submit the TSS applications for FY 2009-10 and execute any agreements necessary for the purpose of developing, submitting, and implementing these grant application projects.
