

## **STATE AWARDS REGION \$66 MILLION FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS**

### *Proposition 1B Funds State Transportation Improvement Program Augmentation*

SACRAMENTO – The California Transportation Commission approved \$66 million in transportation projects in Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties at its June 7 meeting. Proposition 1B, the transportation infrastructure bond measure, set aside \$2 billion statewide for state and local partnerships, through the two-year State Transportation Improvement Program. The Sacramento Area Council of Governments nominated projects in Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties, while the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency and the El Dorado County Transportation Planning Commission nominated projects in their counties.

Among the major projects funded with the STIP Augmentation component and approved by the CTC last Thursday are: a Highway 99 Interchange at Sheldon Road in Elk Grove (\$10,962,000); Antelope Road widening in Citrus Heights (\$6,200,000); Intermodal Depot retrofit in city of Sacramento (\$10,500,000); Paratransit vehicle replacement for Sacramento Regional Transit (\$4,335,000); Highway 70 widening in Yuba and Sutter counties (\$8,856,000); and additional funding for U.S. 50 interchange at Harbor Boulevard in West Sacramento (\$7,551,000).
