### SACOG TO ADOPT 28-YEAR METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN

**Who:** The Sacramento Area Council of Governments Board of Directors, made up of elected officials from El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties and the 22 cities within them

**What:** The Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2035 (MTP2035) will be a 28-year plan for investing \$42 billion in roads, transit, and land use and air quality programs.

**When:** Thursday, March 20 – 9 a.m.

**Why:** The MTP2035 invests \$42 billion over 28 years, proactively linking transportation, land use and air quality. Since 2005, nearly 8,000 people have helped shape the region's transportation future through community workshops, presentations, a televised forum, public opinion research and direct feedback. The MTP2035 also builds on the Blueprint Preferred Growth Scenario, which gives individuals more housing and transportation choices, as well as promoting better land uses and quality design.
