



Funding Programs

SACOG offers different funding programs to support project-specific efforts to implement Blueprint principles. Each program has a specific objective and are normally selected on a competitive basis every two years. The programs are offered to SACOG members (cities and counties) in Sacramento, Sutter, Yuba and Yolo counties. In some cases, the members in El Dorado and Placer counties may participate in these programs, but generally these two counties have their own independent programs.

Air Quality Funding Program

This program funds transportation-related activities that help the region reach air-quality attainment status.

Bicycle/Pedestrian Funding Program

This program helps fund capital and non-capital bicycle and pedestrian projects in communities throughout Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties.

Transportation Demand Management Funding Program

This program provides funds to activities that focus on moving people through the region more efficiently through carpooling, vanpooling, transit use, walking, and telecommuting.

The Community Design Funding Program

This program provides funding to public and private projects that need assistance in the public right-of-way and implement the Blueprint Principles. Funded projects generally include the street improvements needed for neighborhood and corridor revitalization that have associated infill, mixed use, or compact development projects. The program is available to jurisdictions in Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties.
