Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please accept for your review and approval Administrative Modification #8 to SACOG's 2009/12 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). SACOG staff made the requested changes for the attached project using the authority delegated to staff by the SACOG Board of Directors to process administrative modifications to the MTIP. The proposed changes will not impact SACOG's financial constraint or the region's air quality conformity.


Administrative Modification #8 programs \$2,450,000 of Advance Construction (AC) funds in 2009 to PLA25411, Dick Cook Bridge Replacement. This is an exempt Highway Bridge Program project, currently grouped in VAR10050, the Caltrans State Highway Bridge Replacement Lump Sum. In order to make this revision quickly, SACOG is removing the project from this grouped project listing and is instead grouping it into VAR56000, the general Bridge Reconstruction Lump Sum.

This revision is urgent because Placer County Department of Public Works, the lead agency, needs to begin construct in June in order to avoid disturbing fish habitat. Placer County is willing to advance its own funds now in order to meet this deadline. However, the AC funds must be programmed before Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration can authorize the work.

SACOG and Caltrans normally approve amendments in numerical order. However, we ask that Caltrans approve Administrative Modification #8 immediately, as it does not conflict with the pending Amendment #6 or Administrative Modification #7 and it programs local AC funds that require urgent authorization. I therefore request your expeditious review and approval of the enclosed modification. Upon your approval, this modification will be effective immediately.
