Citizen planners will help develop the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2035

With more than \$30 billion in transportation investments being considered across the six-county region over the next 28 years, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), Valley Vision and our partners are hosting eight simultaneous workshops on November 16 to be linked by technology. SACOG seeks over 2,000 residents for the TALL Order: Moving the Region Forward forum to help prioritize where to invest in our region's transportation system. Participants will act as citizen planners, learning about our region's travel challenges and recommending priority transportation investments.
