Delivering transportation projects, providing public information and serving as a dynamic forum for regional planning and collaboration in the greater Sacramento Metropolitan Area.

What we do

The Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is an association of Sacramento Valley governments formed from the six regional counties—El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba—and the 19 member cities listed below. SACOG’s directors are chosen from the elected boards of its member governments. SACOG’s primary charge is to provide regional transportation planning and funding, as well as a forum for the study and resolution of regional issues. In this role, SACOG prepares the region’s long-range transportation plan; approves distribution of affordable housing around the region; keeps a regionwide database for its own and local agency use; helps counties and cities use federal transportation funds in a timely way; assists in planning for transit, bicycle networks, clean air and airport land uses; and is undertaking a new program to link transportation and land development more closely. SACOG has an annual operating budget of about \$6.1 million, funded from local, regional, state and federal transportation funds. It has a staff of about 50, including employees and consultants. SACOG is located in downtown Sacramento at 3000 S Street, one block from the 29th Street Light Rail Station.
