# SACOG Mission

The Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is an association of local governments formed by six counties and eighteen cities. SACOG serves the Counties of El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba and the Cities of Auburn, Citrus Heights, Davis, Elk Grove, Folsom, Galt, Isleton, Lincoln, Live Oak, Marysville, Rocklin, Roseville, Sacramento, West Sacramento, Wheatland, Winters, Woodland and Yuba City.

SACOG is governed by a Board of Directors composed of County Supervisors or City Councilpersons, appointed by the member jurisdictions. The Board is advised by several policy and technical committees. A full time staff is employed to implement Council policies and work programs as well as coordinate the efforts of consultants who are retained to augment the staff’s efforts.

SACOG serves as an advisory agency to local government on matters of interjurisdictional concern, and has developed a comprehensive planning program in transportation and has been designated to fulfill mandates in airport land use planning and air quality.

## Annual Listing of Projects with Federal Funding for Federal Fiscal Year 2002

---

Federal law requires SACOG to publish for public review an annual listing of projects for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year, as a record of project delivery and a progress report for public information and disclosure.

This report indicates that approximately \$218 million in federal funds were obligated for 162 transportation projects in the region between October, 1, 2001 and September 30, 2002. The federal funding consisted of \$133 million of Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds for road, bicycle/pedestrian facilities, transportation enhancements, and air quality projects, \$6 million in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds for transit projects and \$55 million transferred from FHWA to FTA for transit projects.

The breakdown of expenditures by project type shows:

The six largest projects that use federal funding in the region are: the Sacramento Regional Transit Capital Assistance Project including a variety of transit improvements and the purchase of 66 CNG buses (\$47.2 million in federal funding), the Caltrans project to build HOV lanes on Rt 50 and modify the interchange 50 at Sunrise Boulevard (\$18.8 million), the Caltrans project to rehabilitate the bridge over the American River on I-5 (\$16.7 million), the Caltrans project to rehabilitate US 50 in El Dorado County (\$13.4 million), the Caltrans project to rehabilitate Rt. 99 near Mack Road (\$8.5 million) and the City of Sacramento project to extend 7<sup>th</sup> St. from E to North B (\$7.7 million). It should be noted that, in addition to federal funding, state and local agencies use approximately \$500 million of state, local and private funding each year for transportation projects in the region.
