Project Description	The City of Folsom in partnership with State Parks and the Bureau of Reclamation is requesting funds to fill the last gap in the 16-mile Humbug-Willow Creek (HBWC) trail system and to prepare plans and specifications for a bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing of Folsom Blvd. The completion of the final gap in the HBWC trail will transform the 16-mile HBWC trail from a local to a regional facility connecting

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	<p>4 trails together. The proposed trail is 4,000 linear feet, 10-feet wide and includes two bridges over Humbug-Willow creek along the route. The proposed overcrossing will provide connections with existing Class I trails on the east and west sides of Folsom Blvd. and will support access to a planned Transit Oriented Development (TOD) abutting the Glenn Drive Light Rail Station.</p>
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
