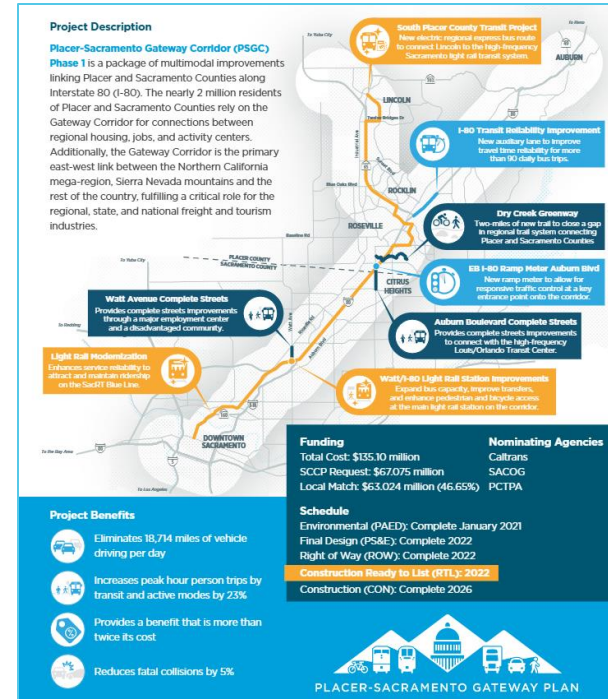

# Purpose of the Program

- ▶▶ Advance initiatives that align with the 2025 Blueprint.
- ↑ Increase the region's ability to secure competitive state and federal funding.
- 🔑 Identify key regional transportation projects for major federal or state grants.
- ♟️ Strategic endorsements, technical support, and advocacy.

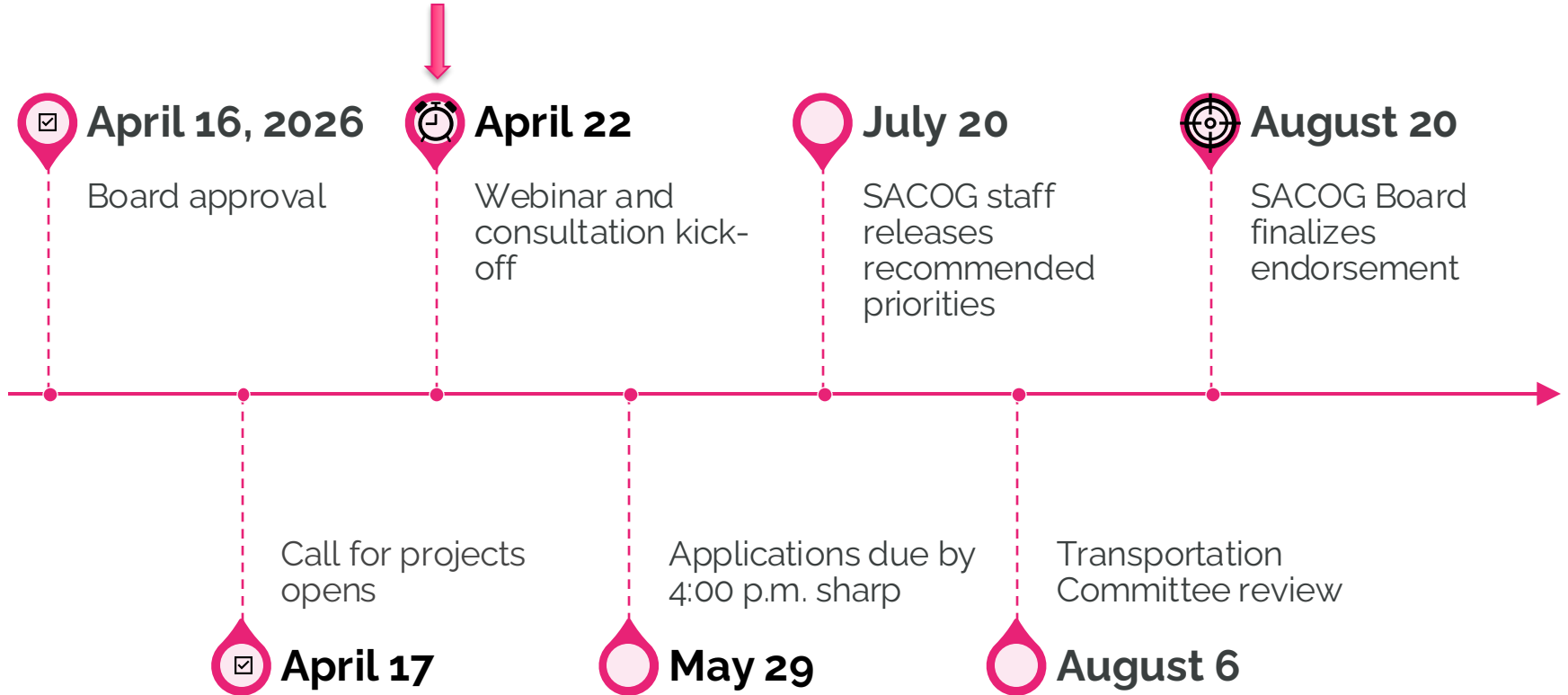
## Program is:

- SACOG's process to identify regionally significant projects.
- Improve regional coordination and increase competitiveness for major federal and state grant programs.
- SACOG regional endorsement, advocacy, and technical support.
- Identifies projects with strong regional impact and 2025 Blueprint alignment.

## Program is not:

- A source of SACOG funding.
- SACOG project management or delivery.
- A competitive advantage for SACOG funding rounds.
- A barrier to apply for other funding opportunities not associated with the program.

# 2026 SB 1 Programs



- **Trade Corridor Enhancement Program**
  - SACOG Prioritization Approach:
    - CTC requires that SACOG nominate applications.
    - SACOG scores, ranks and nominates projects.
  - Program Information:
    - Purpose: improve trade corridors.
    - Funding Available: ~\$800 million

---

# 2026 SB 1 Programs

## - Solutions for Congested Corridors Program



- SACOG Prioritization Approach: SACOG can act as applicant or co-applicant on up to two applications that meet the scoring threshold.
- Program Information:
  - Purpose: funding projects to reduce congestion in heavily traveled corridors.
  - Projects must be included in a Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan.
  - Funding Amount: ~\$500 million
  - Eligible applicants: Regional transportation planning agencies, Caltrans.

# 2026 SB 1 Programs



- **Local Partnership Program (Competitive)**
  - o No SACOG Prioritization Approach
    - o *SACOG checks 2025 Blueprint consistency only.*
  - o Program Information:
    - Purpose / Eligibility: Fund projects for Jurisdictions with voter approved taxes, tolls, or fees for transportation
      - Check with CTC staff
    - Funding Amount: ~\$400 Million

# Intake Form

- *Applicant and Project Background*
- Streamlines application process.
- Fill out completely. SACOG will follow-up with a consultation request.
- SACOG ID or Project ID from prior process OK.
- Any issues – contact SACOG staff.

---

# Application Screening and Evaluation

## Project Screening

- ✓ Six-county region
- ✓ Consistent with the 2025 Blueprint
- ✓ Federal-aid eligible
- ✓ Eligible for funding program

## SACOG Internal Evaluation

- ✓ **Regional** benefit & support for the 2025 Blueprint (0-10)
- ✓ **Competitiveness** for the targeted funding program (0-10)
- ✓ **Readiness** to deliver (0-10)

---

# SACOG Application Guidance & Tips

- **SCCP**

- Submit projects in one corridor package.
- Coordinate with corridor partners.
- Project map: show all projects.
- Discuss benefits from package of projects collectively.

- **Regional Need**

- Review 2025 Blueprint.
- List Relevant Policies & Transportation Project Information.
- *Consider supplemental data as need.*

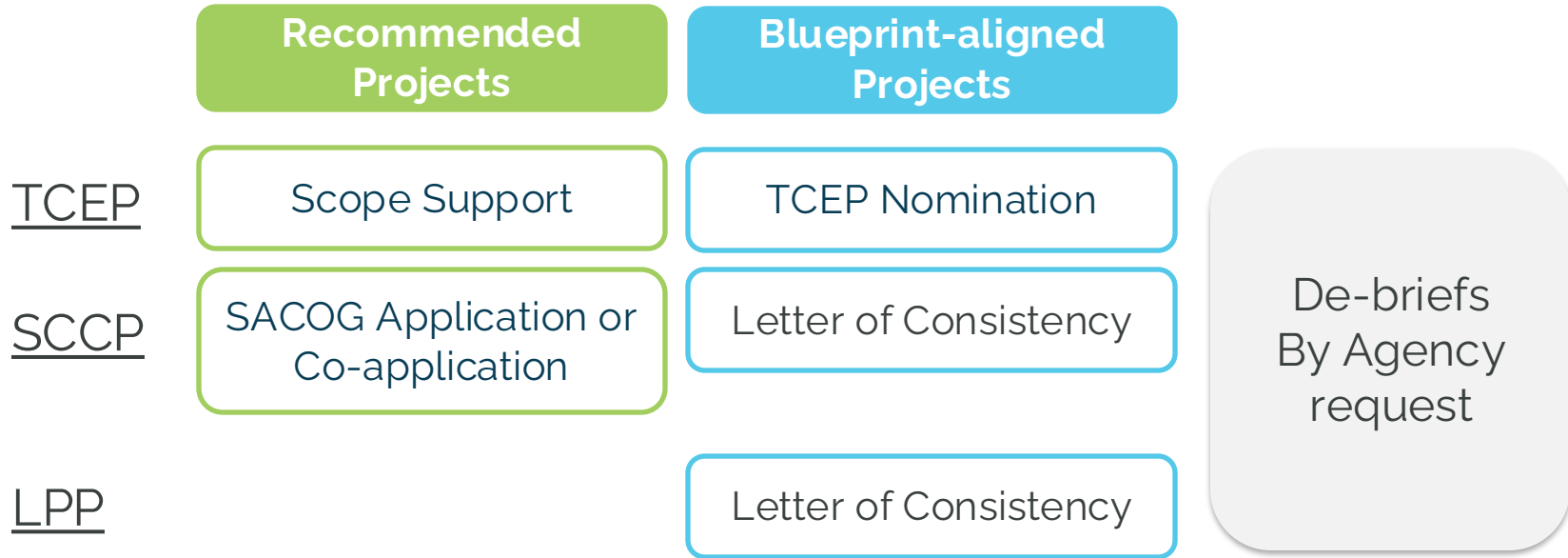
- **Competitiveness**

- Review program guidelines and scoring criteria.
- Narrative response to describe qualitative and quantitative methods to align with scoring criteria.
- *Consider supplemental data as need.*

- **Delivery Readiness**

- Complete PPR – milestones and funding.
