DRAFT ACTION MINUTES

The SACOG Transportation Committee met on February 1, 2018 in the Rivers Rooms on the Third Floor of the Meridian Plaza Building, located at 1415 L Street, Sacramento, CA, at 10:00 a.m.

Chair Cabaldon called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. CALL TO ORDER:

ROLL CALL: Present: Directors Crews, Holmes, Peters, Sander, Saylor, Slowey,

Vasquez, Veerkamp, Vice Chair Joiner, Vice Chair Suen, Chair

Cabaldon, and Ex-Officio Member Flournoy (for Benipal)

Absent: None

Public Communication: Jeff Tardaguila, an advocate for Disability Organizing Group for Initiating Total Equality, and Older Women's League, commented on unmet transit needs. David Schwegel, an advocate for Precision Civil Engineering and American Society of Civil Engineers, spoke in regard to high speed rail.

1. Minutes of the February 1, 2018, Meeting

Upon motion by Director Slowey, seconded by Vice Chair Suen, the Transportation Committee unanimously approved the minutes as submitted.

2. Support for Caltrans Statewide Safety Performance Management Targets

Upon motion by Director Peters, seconded by Director Veerkamp, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board: (1) approve as SACOG's 2018 targets the five statewide safety performance targets set by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to meet federal requirements; and (2) authorize the CEO to execute the necessary addendum to SACOG's Memorandum of Understanding with Caltrans.

3. **SACOG Transportation Committee Charge**

Upon motion by Director Veerkamp, seconded by Director Saylor, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board adopt the committee charge as submitted.

4. **Senate Bill 1 Solutions for Congested Corridors Project Nominations**

Upon motion by Director Slowey, seconded by Director Saylor, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board: (1) nominate that the eight projects identified in the staff report receive a nomination to apply for funding

through the Senate Bill 1 Solutions for Congested Corridors Program; and (2) establish priority rankings, or tiers, of the nominated projects.

5. Big Data Pilot Project

Upon motion by Director Slowey, seconded by Vice Chair Suen, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board approve SACOG's entry into a partnership with the California Air Resources Board (CARB), and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for pilot testing a transportation planning application of big data, and authorize the chief executive officer to negotiate and sign necessary agreements to carry out the pilot effort.

6. Unmet Transit Needs Findings for Sacramento Regional Transit District, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba Counties, and the Cities Therein

Upon motion by Director Crews, seconded by Director Vasquez, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board: (1) approve the minutes (Attachments F-I) of the five public hearings held on unmet transit needs in Sacramento County, including the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SRTD) and cities therein, and in Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties and the cities therein, and of the public hearing held on January 18, 2018, before the SACOG Board of Directors; and (2) adopt the attached resolutions regarding the FY 2018-19 unmet transit needs in each county, cities therein, and the SRTD.

Helen O'Connell, an advocate for Disability Organizing Group for Initiating Total Equality, spoke in regards to Sacramento Regional Transit, requesting information at stops to indicate Monday-Friday only service and Sunday service to reflect the same or a limited version of their respective Monday through Saturday schedules.

7. FY 2018/19 Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Planning Grants

Upon motion by Director Saylor, seconded by Director Holmes, the Transportation Committee unanimously recommended that the Board: (1) approve the resolution in the staff report to be submitted to Caltrans with SACOG applications for discretionary funding; and (2) authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute funding agreements associated with these grant applications if awarded funding by Caltrans.

8. 2020 Metropolitan Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy: Update and Look Ahead

The Transportation Committee received and reviewed this report, presented by Mr. Holtzen, SACOG staff.

9. Civic Lab Update
