- 654 total respondents

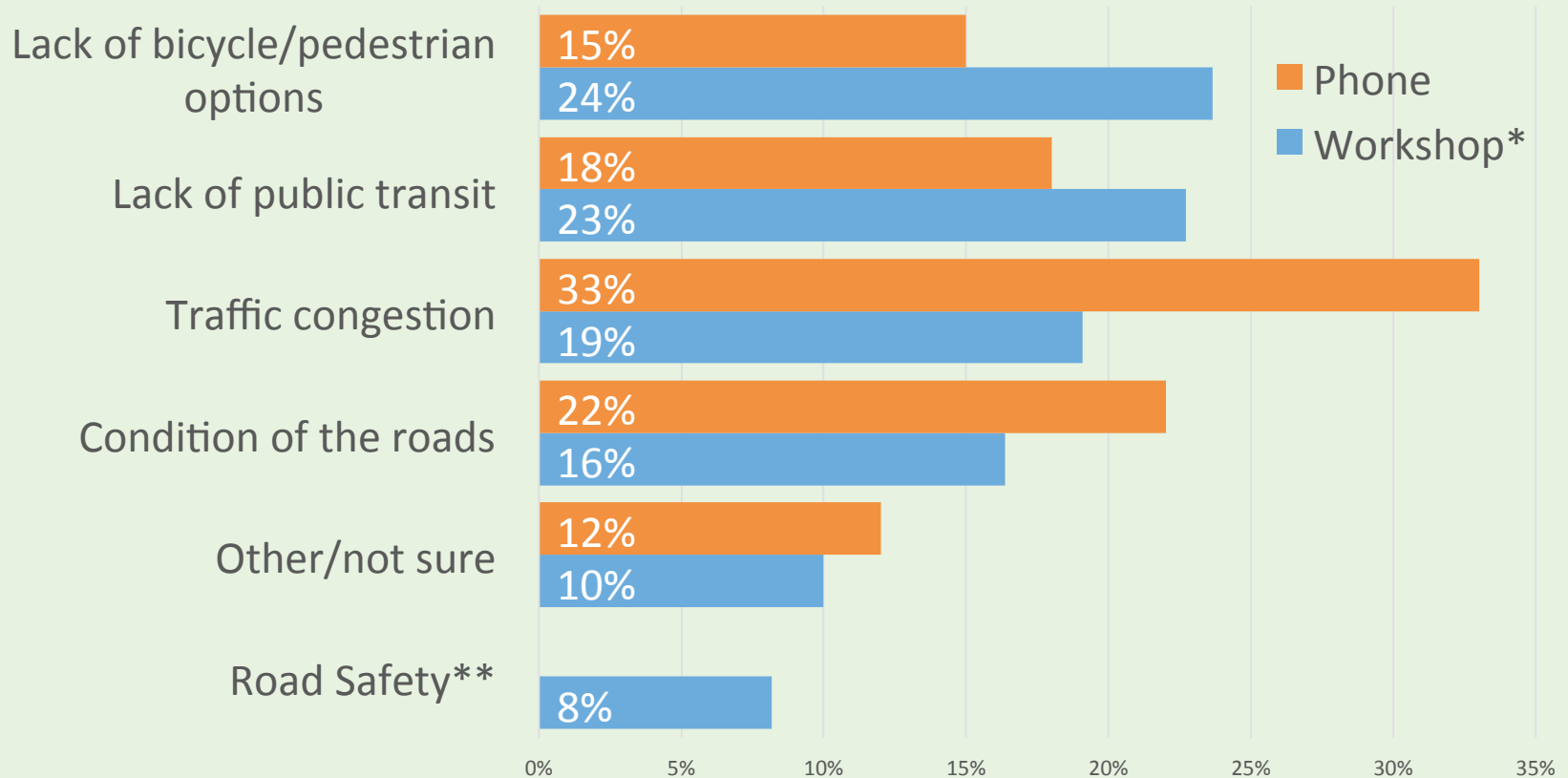
Workshop/Online Survey Results

Key Findings:

- Demographics generally close to regional composition of phone poll
- Many responses very similar to phone poll
- Respondents want funds for road repair and transit

Workshop v Phone surveys: Biggest Problem in Your Area:

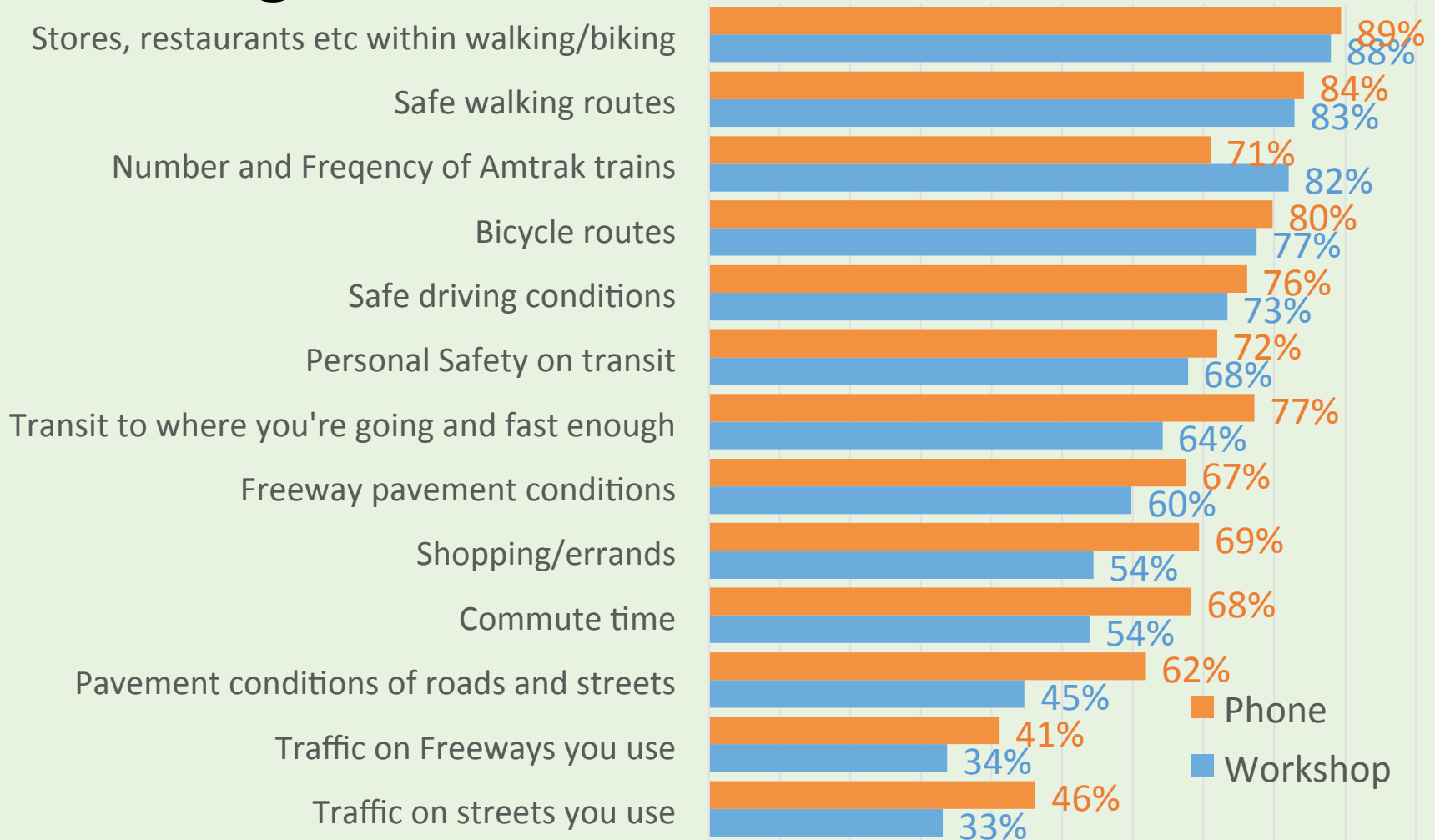
Biggest Transportation Problem -- Phone and Workshop Surveys



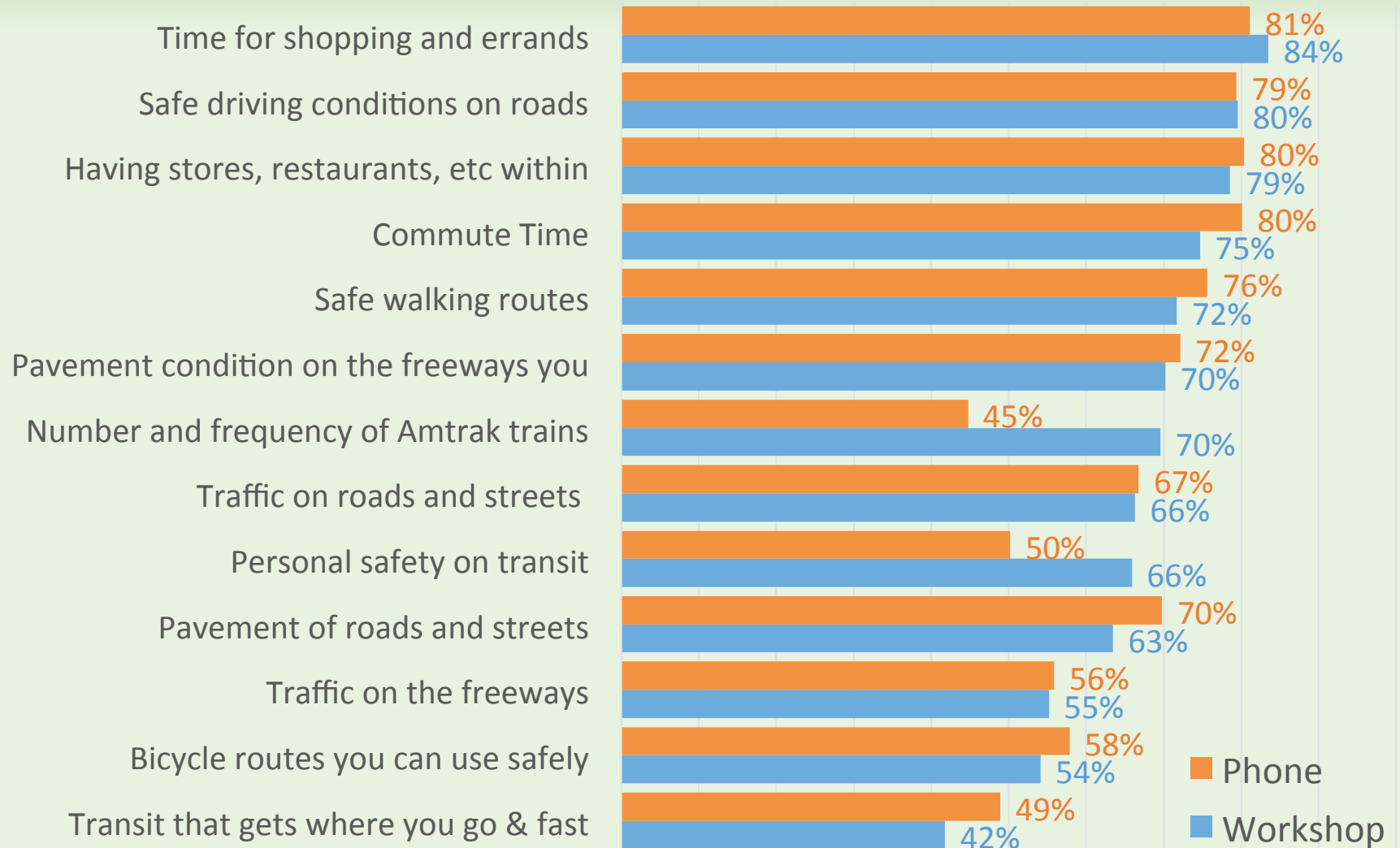
*Initial percentages in workshop poll summed to 110% because some respondents selected multiple options. Percentages were recomputed to base 100%

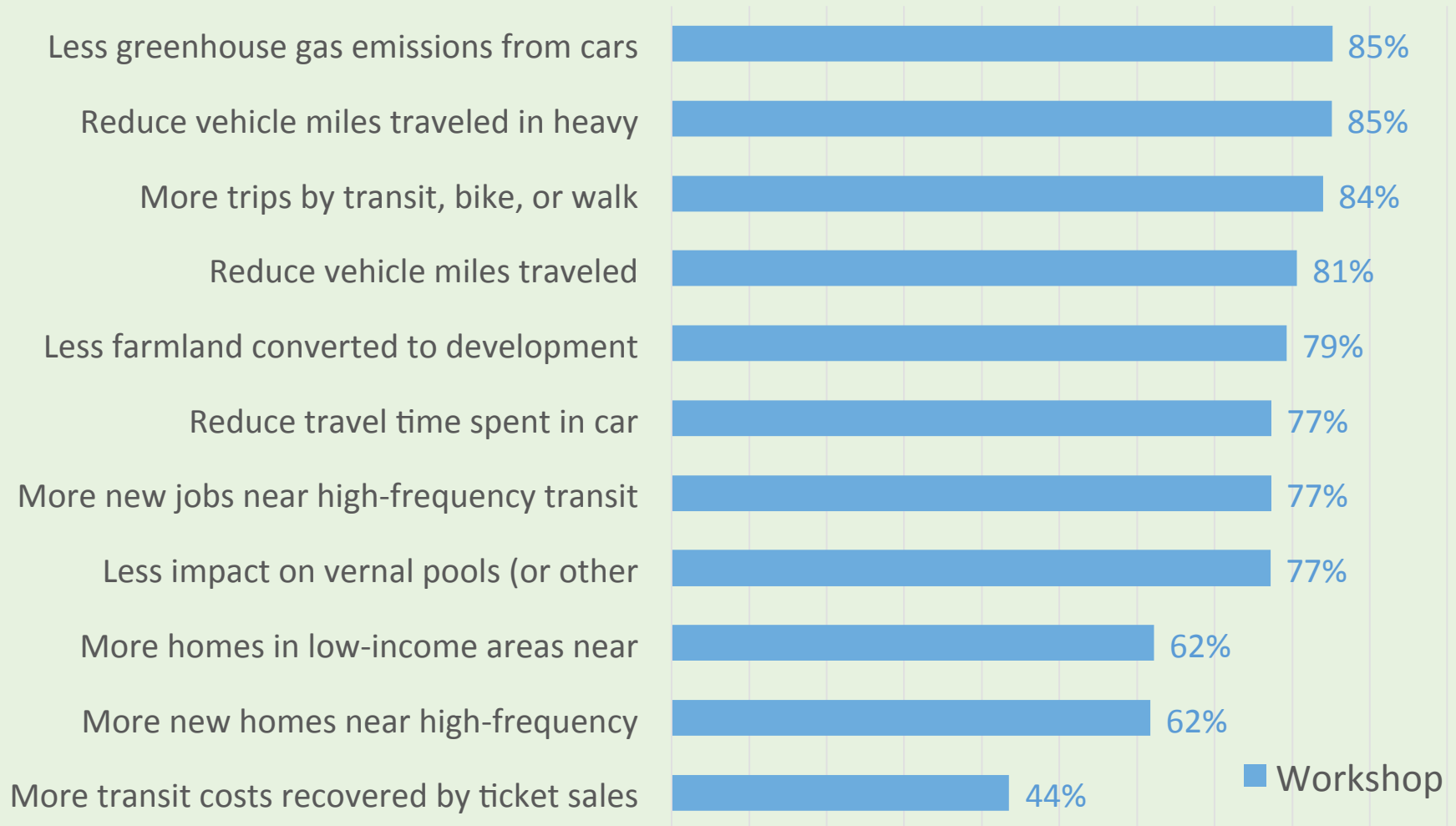
Workshop v Phone surveys: Getting better or remain the same:



Workshop v Phone surveys: Fine as is or Needs a Little Improvement

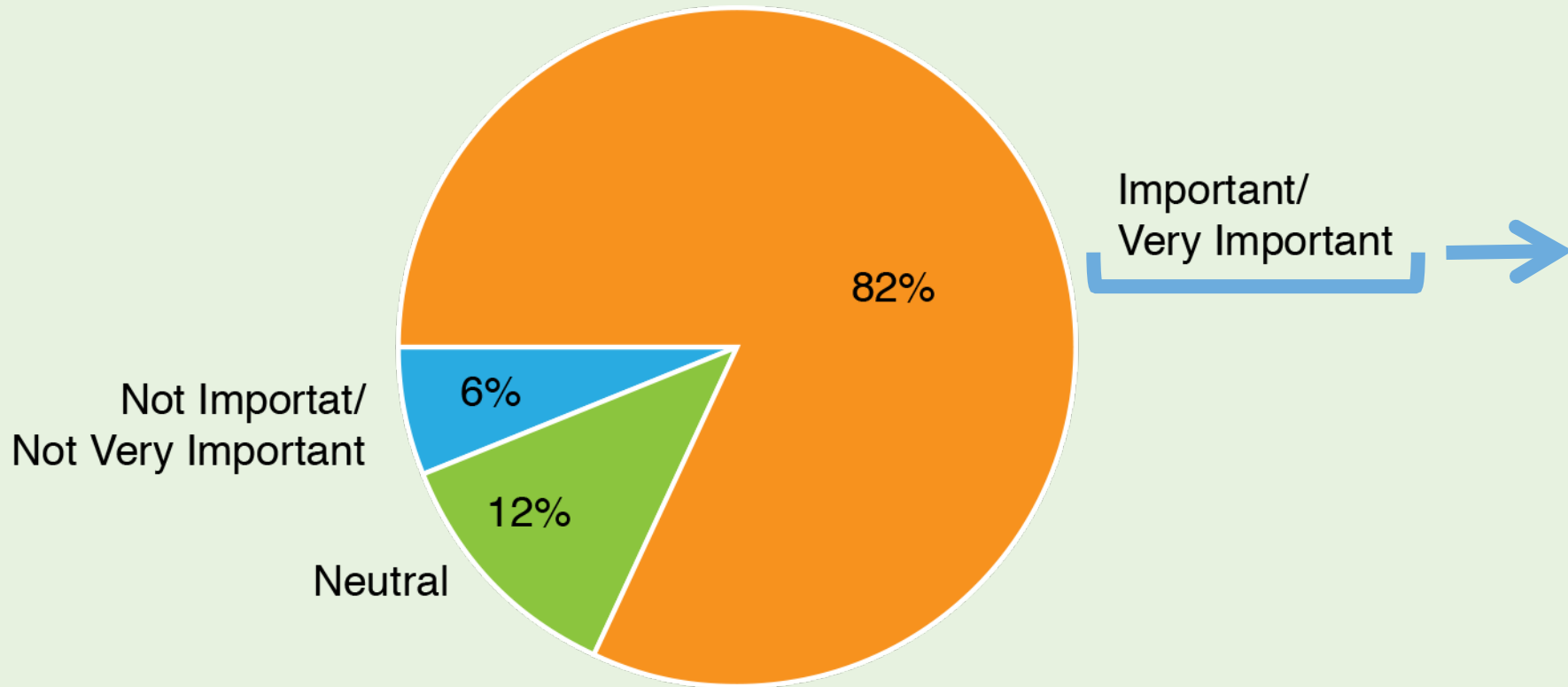

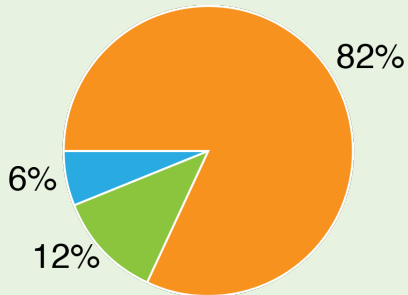

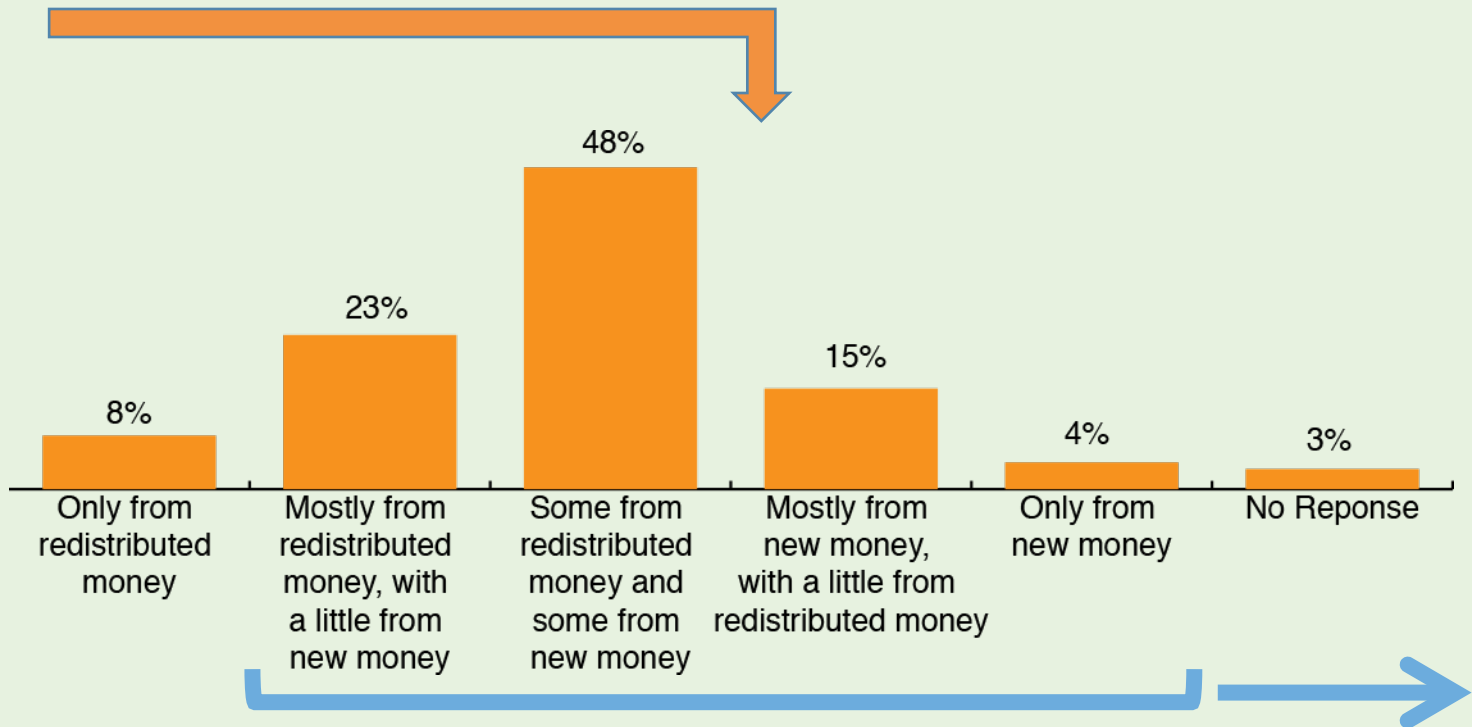
Increased Funding for Existing Road and Highway System



Workshop/Online only questions: **Existing Funds or New Funds**



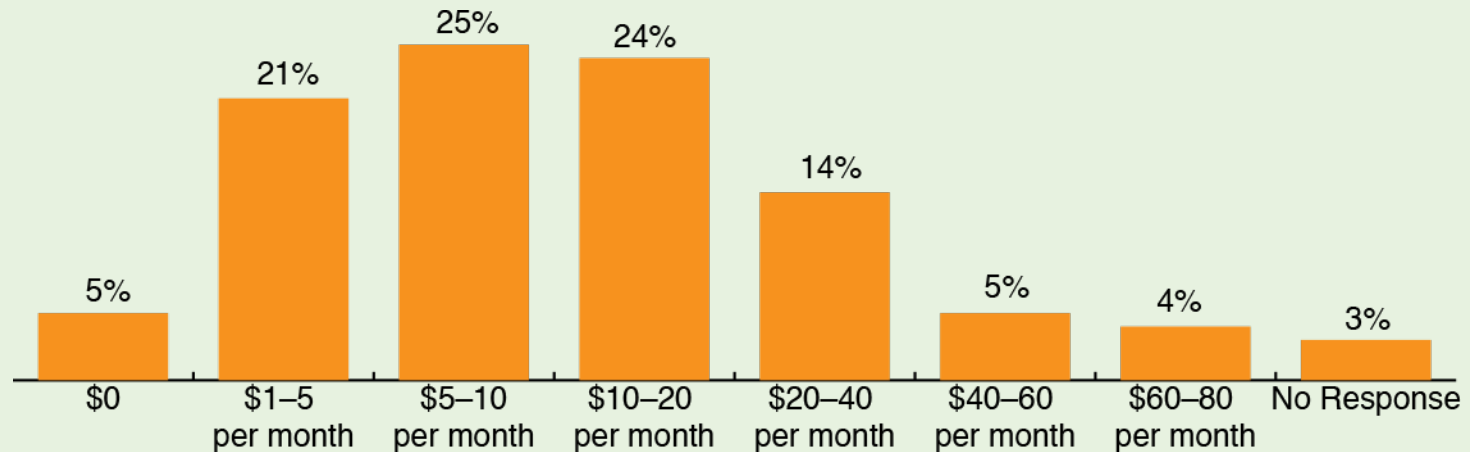

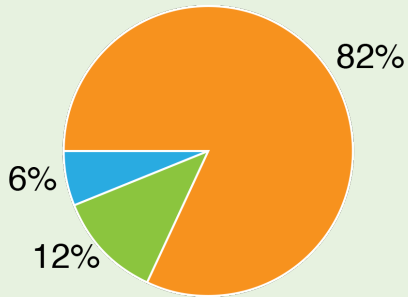
Household Willingness to Pay

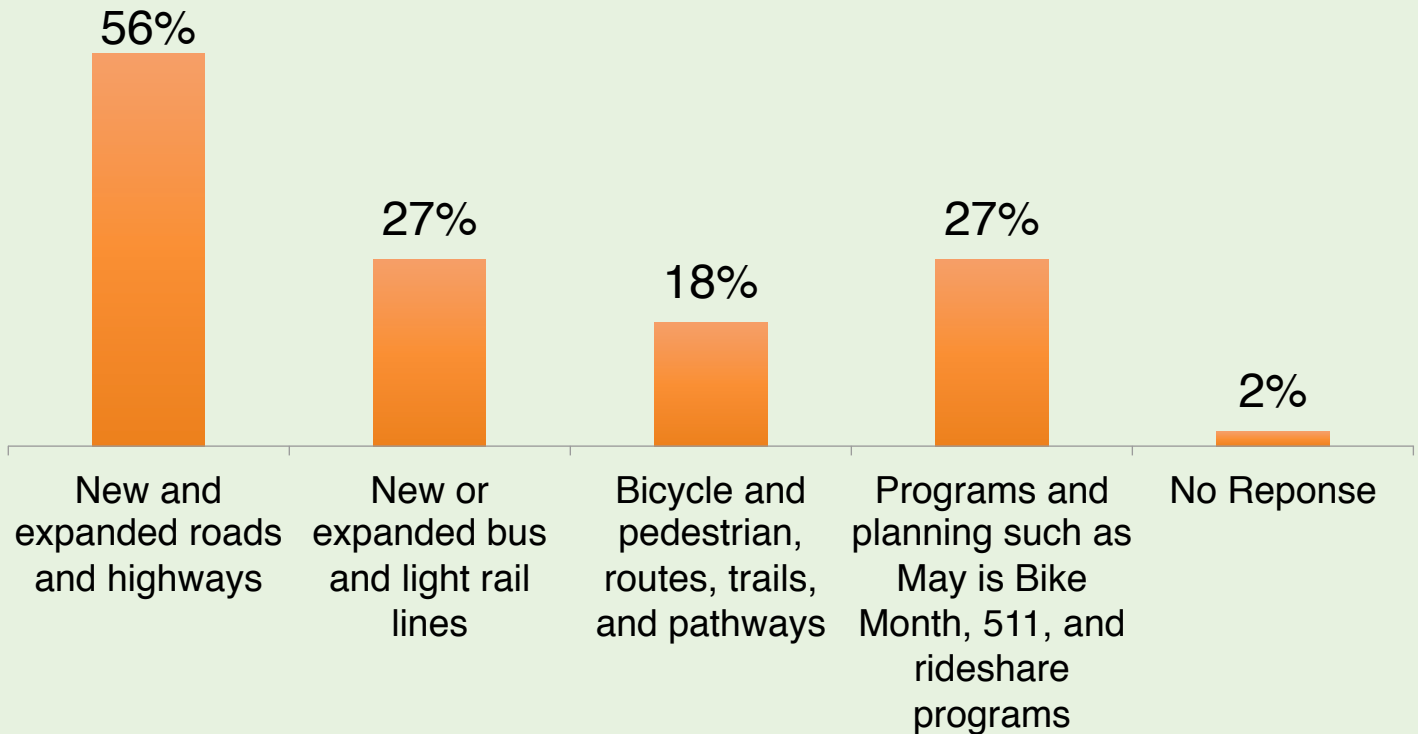

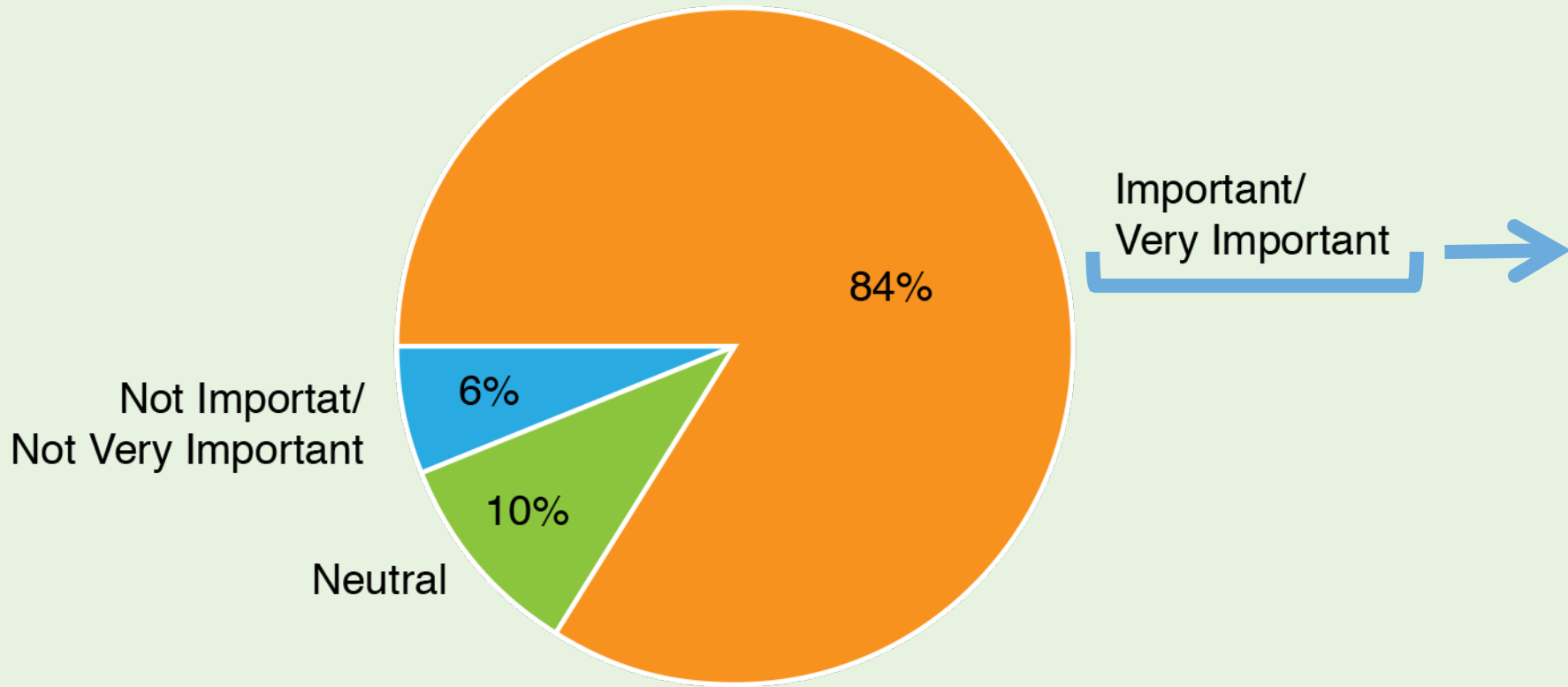

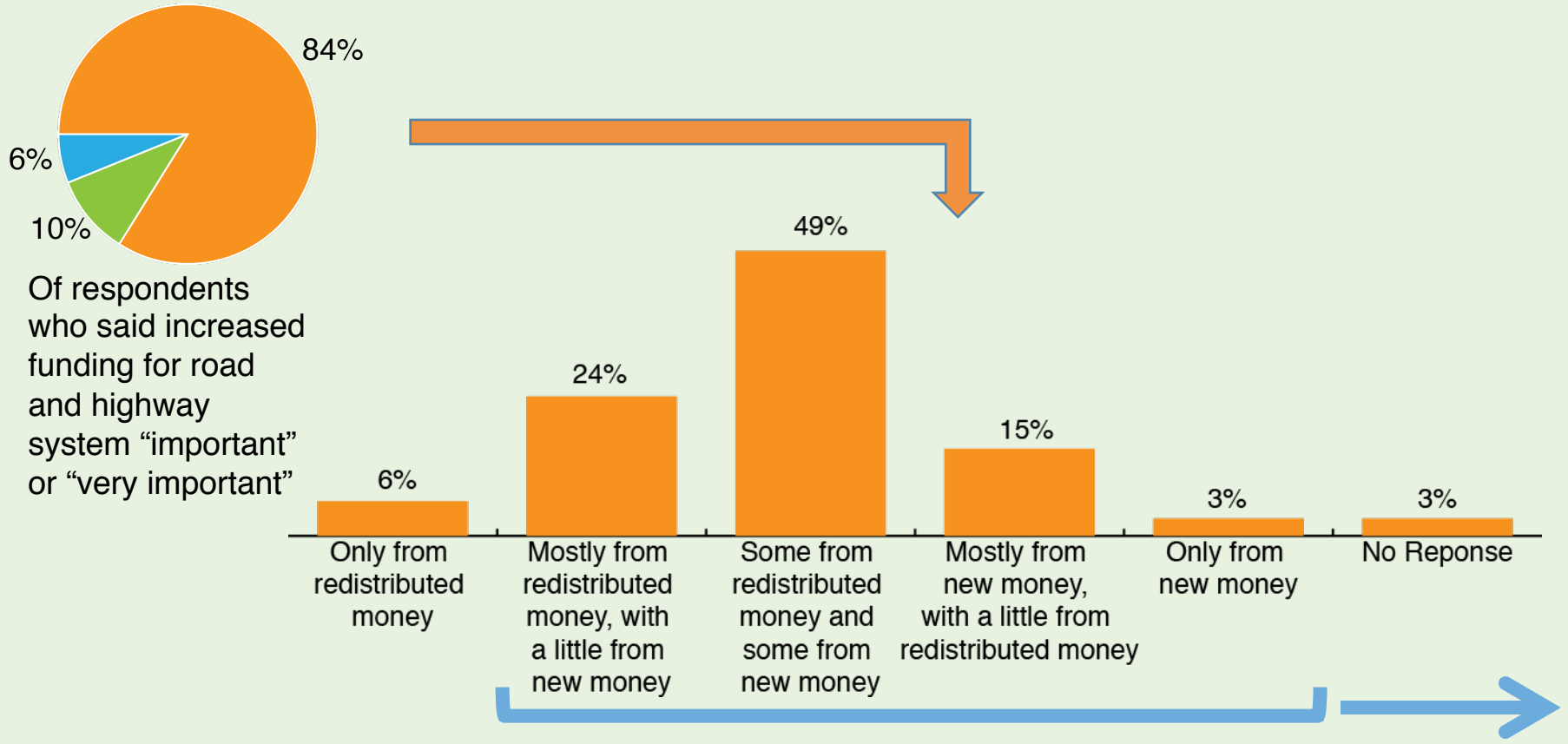


Very Important or Important

Increased Funding for Existing Bus and Light Rail System



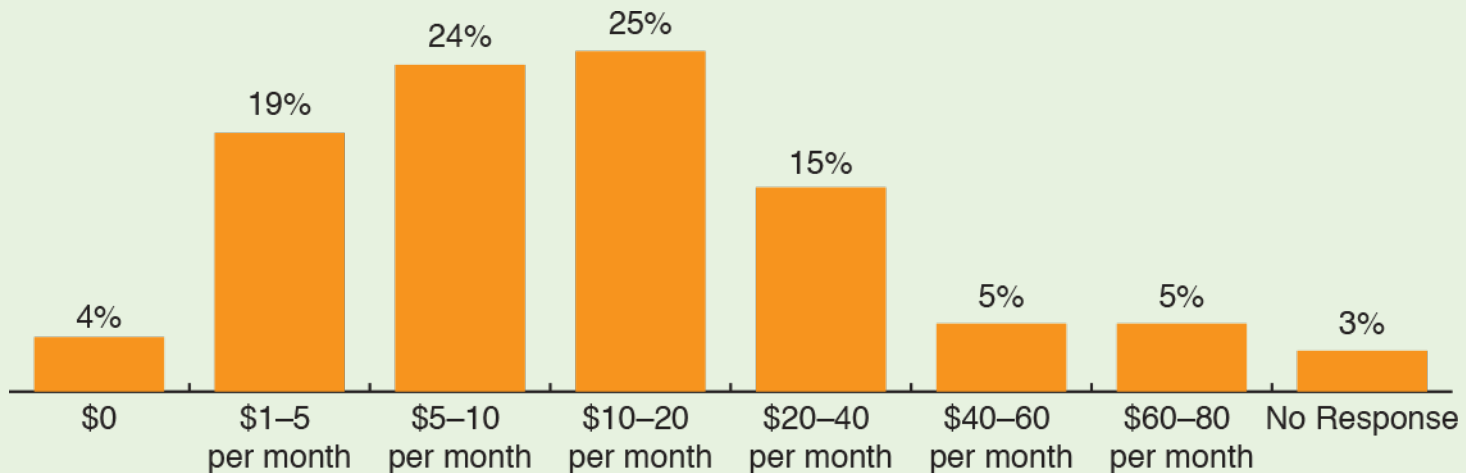

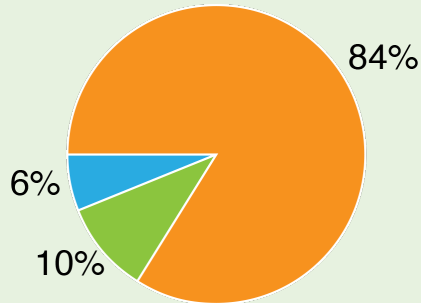
