**3. Background/Analysis:**

At the SACOG Board Retreat in October 2017, concern was expressed by board members from across the region about the future of transit due to the disruptions in funding and technology. As a result, "help the region advance a vision for next generation transit" became one of the ten SACOG work plan goals for 2018-2019.

**4. Discussion/Analysis:**

The workshop speakers will cover active transit planning and service delivery efforts that are innovative and future-oriented.

Nadine Lee is the Deputy Chief Innovation Officer for Los Angeles Metro's Office of Extraordinary Innovation. Metro has launched many new transit pilot programs in transit that incorporate new technologies and creative public-private partnerships.

James Boyle is the Director of Planning at the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT). James is the project manager for SacRT Forward - a significant and comprehensive transit service redesign planning effort that is being completed in collaboration with Jarrett Walker + Associates.
