### **FY 2015-16 Caltrans Transportation Planning Discretionary Grants**

In October 2014, the SACOG Board of Directors approved the submission by SACOG of applications to Caltrans for its FY 2015/16 Discretionary Planning Grant round. In April 2015, Caltrans announced its awards. Two of the three applications were funded. Results were as follows:

SACOG is also a subrecipient with San Joaquin COG on a grant awarded to lead applicant MTC. This grant is for a study to improve key system bottlenecks and the efficiency of first and last mile access to major goods movement facilities and activity centers in Northern California. SACOG will be including new grant projects in the FY 2015/16 OWP and completing subrecipient agreements as needed.

Caltrans guidelines permitted more agencies to apply directly for grant funding in this round. Other announced grant awards in the SACOG region are for an El Dorado County Active Transportation Connections Study; a Master Plan for the Watt/I-80 Transit Center; and a student internship program at the Yolo County Transportation District.
