Approve the Transportation Development Act Claim for the City of Sacramento

Issue: The Transportation Development Act (TDA) authorizes eligible cities, counties, and transit operators to receive TDA funds for transportation purposes and street and road projects. The TDA funds are made available from sales tax receipts.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board approve the TDA claim listed below.

Committee Action/Discussion: Current Board policy calls for routine TDA allocations to cities, counties, and transit operators to come directly to the Board without review by a committee.
