RESOLUTION NO. 1 – 2012

APPROVING THE CITY OF ISLETON’S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FY 2010-11 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$76,990

WHEREAS, the city of Isleton has submitted a claim for Local Transportation Funds under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2010-11 in the amount of \$76,900, and such funds will be used as follows:
