RESOLUTION NO. 2 – 2012

**APPROVING CITY OF YUBA CITY'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT
CLAIM FOR FY 2011-12 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,409,549**

WHEREAS, the city of Yuba City has submitted an amended claim for Local Transportation Funds under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act, for FY 2011-12 in the amount of \$1,409,549, and such funds will be used as follows:

WHEREAS, such claim is consistent with State Law, with Guidelines adopted by the Board, and with approved apportionments for FY 2011-12; and

WHEREAS, the Board Resolution No.33- 2011 on April 21, 2011, finding that there are no unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet in the city of Yuba City; and

WHEREAS, the city of Yuba City has provided the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority with sufficient funds (\$739,174) to provide transit services within the city for FY 2011-12;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby approves the request for Local Transportation Funds for FY 2011-12 in the amount of \$1,409,549, and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the city of Yuba City in proportion to funds received from the State.
