### Approve the Revised Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan for Sacramento International Airport

**Issue:** Should SACOG, serving as the Airport Land Use Commission, approve the revised Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for Sacramento International Airport?

**Recommendation:** That the Land Use & Natural Resources Committee make an advisory recommendation to the Airport Land Use Commission to approve the revised ALUCP for Sacramento International Airport by resolution.

**Discussion:** The SACOG Board of Directors, serving as the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), approved the public release of the revised draft of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for Sacramento International Airport (SMF) at its November 14, 2013 meeting. The revised draft ALUCP addressed the issues that were raised by stakeholders in the initial draft plan that was released by the ALUC at its May 16, 2013 meeting. Each stakeholder who provided written comments regarding the May draft was contacted about the proposed revisions in the revised draft plan, and each has indicated that the changes are satisfactory. Since the revised draft plan was released in November, only one clarifying request has been submitted and staff is recommending modification to the plan as shown in the attachment.

Attached are: (1) Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) #3, summarizing: the basics of what the ALUCP is required to address by state law, the key components of the draft ALUCP, the key issues raised by public comments, and how the key issues are addressed in the revised ALUCP; (2) comment letters with references to key statements; (3) a response matrix to the key comments; and (4) the main chapter of the revised ALUCP, which addresses policies. The FAQ #3 is meant to provide ALUC members a stand-alone summary of the ALUCP and the pertinent policy issues. The remaining items provide more detailed background information. Additional information is available on the SACOG website, <http://www.sacog.org/airport/>, and includes the full 240 page draft ALUCP, the 100 page Initial Study and earlier FAQs.

At its December 12, 2013 meeting, the ALUC will be asked to first adopt a Negative Declaration/Initial Study by resolution (see prior agenda item), and then to approve the revised ALUCP by resolution.
