### **Approve SACOG Managed Funds for the City of Wheatland Bicycle Master Plan and City of Isleton Road Rehabilitation Project**

**Issue:** Should the Strategic Planning Committee, with its delegated authority from the Board of Directors, authorize SACOG to swap committed Regional Surface Transportation (RSTP) funds with SACOG Managed Funds on the City of Wheatland's Bicycle Master Plan and City of Isleton's Road Rehabilitation Project?

**Recommendation:** That the Strategic Planning Committee 1) authorize staff to swap committed RSTP funds with SACOG Managed Funds on the City of Wheatland's Bicycle Master Plan and City of Isleton's Road Rehabilitation Project and 2) authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute any necessary Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Wheatland and City of Isleton.

**Discussion:** As part of the 2006 funding round, the Board approved the selection and funding of the City of Wheatland Bicycle Master Plan for \$27,000. The project was programmed with RSTP funds. As part of the 2007 and 2008 funding rounds, the Board approved Roadway Rehabilitation funds for the City of Isleton totaling \$11,574 of RSTP funds. The funding of projects of this size and nature using federal dollars is no longer a practice of recent SACOG funding rounds due to the cost and complexity of federalizing a project. Recent funding rounds utilize available SACOG Managed Funds for these types of projects.

Staff is proposing to enter into an MOU with the City of Wheatland to allow it to use local SACOG Managed Funds for their Bicycle Master Plan and take advantage of an easier process. Staff is also proposing to enter into an MOU with the City of Isleton to allow it to combine local SACOG Managed Funds with other transportation funding to design and/or construct a transportation project as agreed to with staff. The MOU will state the specific scope of the transportation project that will use the SACOG Managed funds. This action will align these projects with SACOG's current funding practices.
