Scope of Work	The City of Galt "C" Street/Central Galt Complete Streets Project will enhance connectivity to Galt's Historic Old Town and Downtown from the reconfigured Central Galt Interchange. The goal of this project is to increase the bicycle and pedestrian use of the community's central business corridor in a safe and aesthetically pleasing manner. The project will construct the following improvements on "C" Street and Fourth Street: new wide sidewalks with enhanced pavement and landscaped planters, accessible ramps at street corners incorporating bulb-outs, crosswalks with enhanced pavement and refuge median islands (on C Street) and pedestrian scale lighting.
