Update on Regional Active Transportation Program Cycle 1

Issue: Staff will brief the Committee on projects awarded through the 2014 SACOG Six-County Regional Active Transportation Program (ATP) and seek feedback on the program and process.

Recommendation: None, for discussion only.

Discussion: In September, the Board of Directors approved the SACOG Six-County Regional ATP (Regional ATP) project list, concluding a multi-month process to program \$9.8 million of ATP funds that support active transportation by increasing the number of bicyclists and pedestrians, improving safety, and meeting other related goals. Successful project applications have been added to the SACOG ATP webpage along with award information. Following approval of the project list by the SAOCG Board of Directors, staff has coordinated with the California Transportation Commission (CTC) to ensure that the projects (Attachment A) are programmed correctly to minimize the risk of loss of funds in our region. This list of projects is scheduled to be adopted by the CTC on November 12, 2014.

Given the rapid approach of ATP Cycle 2, staff is seeking Committee feedback on the strengths and weaknesses of the inaugural Regional ATP in an effort to identify opportunities to streamline subsequent ATP rounds. Renée Devere-Oki, the SACOG Programming and Project Delivery Team Manager, will conduct a feedback session on the Regional ATP process, from the drafting of SACOG Guidelines, to the working group process to develop a funding recommendation, to the final Board approval of the project list.
