### Regional Bike Share Request for Proposals Update

**Issue:** Should SACOG staff recommend the award of bike share system operator & equipment and sponsorship & advertisement development contracts directly to the SACOG Board?

**Recommendation:** None; this item is for information and discussion.

**Discussion:**

On May 3, 2016 SACOG released a Request for Proposals (RFPs) for a Bike Share System Operator and Equipment, as well as a RFP for Bike Share System Sponsorship and Advertisement development as authorized by the SACOG Board on April 21, 2016. The RFPs can be viewed on SACOG's RFP hosting services, Public Purchase, using the following link: <http://www.sacog.org/do-business-us>

SACOG is moving as quickly as possible to advertise and award both Regional Bike Share System contracts to meet our target of launching the system by Spring 2017. Although it is possible that issues could come up during the bidding process that compel a prudent delay in this schedule, if we are going to maintain this ambitious schedule, SACOG will need to take Board action in June to delegate authority to the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and enter into contracts. The reason is that the RFP schedule does not permit time to bring a recommendation to the Transportation Committee on June 2. A delay in Board action past June would result in a two-month delay due to the Board's calendar.

The RFP has been released with this schedule and process in mind. However, if the Committee does not agree with this recommendation, the RFP schedule can be modified through an addendum to accommodate the Committee.
