Cannabis Regulation & Policies Discussion

Issue: As state law related to cannabis changes, how is the local/regional regulatory and policy environment changing?

Recommendation: None; this item is for information only.

Discussion: SACOG staff was directed by the Land Use and Natural Resources Committee to assemble a panel of experts on cannabis to help the committee and other board members understand policy options and regulatory approaches to cannabis industry expansion. SACOG will host a luncheon on Thursday, October 19, following the Board meeting. Board members will have the opportunity to hear from both public and private stakeholders.

Staff is seeking input from the committee to finalize content for the panel. Topics that are being considered for this panel are listed below:

1. How to regulate location, size, and other zoning standards for:
 - a. Grow operations
 - b. Processors
 - c. Distributors
 - d. Dispensaries
2. Policy priorities, for example:
 - a. Eliminating black market operations
 - b. Ensuring public health and safety
 - c. Taxation and how to use revenues
3. Land use impacts, such as:
 - a. Increases in agriculture land value
 - b. Changes in cropping patterns
 - c. Increases in warehousing prices and decreases in availability
4. Consumer issues, such as:
 - a. Product labeling and warnings
 - b. Tourism
 - c. Education and counseling
5. Enforcement issues, including:
 - a. Intoxicated driving
 - b. Industry monitoring and reporting
 - c. Product standards and testing
