Elected Officials Plug-In Electric Vehicle Planning Ad-Hoc Committee Meeting

Issue: SACOG will be convening the Plug-In Electric Vehicle (PEV) Planning Ad-Hoc Committee.

Recommendation: None, this is for information only.

Discussion: In December of 2011, the SACOG Board created the PEV Planning Ad-Hoc Committee. The committee's charge is to review and provide feedback on regional PEV planning project outcomes including, but not limited to:

- Model policies regarding the siting and pricing of public PEV infrastructure;
- Model building and planning policies, ordinances, and permitting of PEV infrastructure;
- Public infrastructure financing options;
- Specific guidelines related to PEV infrastructure for multi-family dwelling units, workplaces and fleets;
- Marketing and outreach to various stakeholders, including city and county staff, emergency responders, PEV manufacturers and auto sales franchises in the region, and the general public; and
- Plans to mitigate on-peak charging.

The committee has no official membership, but can be comprised of members of the SACOG Board of Directors along with elected officials from the Board of Directors for the Sacramento Municipal Utilities District (SMUD) and any partner agency with PEV interest, as well as any elected official from the six-county SACOG region.

The PEV Planning Ad-Hoc Committee has conducted informal meetings, but has yet to meet as a larger group. SACOG is working with staff from SMUD and the Local Government Commission to start outreach to solicit interest in attending the meeting. A date has not been set for the meeting, but will likely be in late February to mid-March. SACOG staff will present a draft agenda and meeting date during the committee meeting.
