Reaffirming Greenprint and the Regional Green Infrastructure

Issue: The Sacramento Tree Foundation will present on the status of the Greenprint and the Regional Green Infrastructure.

Discussion: The Sacramento Tree Foundation started their Greenprint Initiative in 2005 to promote best management practices for our urban forests.
