Vision Zero Update and Automated Speed Enforcement

The Sacramento City/County Advisory Committee recommended the City and County adopt Vision Zero programs.

San Francisco did a report on Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE). The report, including a slide presentation, is at <http://sfcontroller.org/Modules/ShowDocument.aspx?documentid=6928>.

The report concluded:

1. ASE effectiveness varies, but it is generally effective at improving road safety.
2. It gets a bad reputation in areas where its purpose is perceived as a revenue generator.
3. It gets a bad reputation among those that perceive speeding as an acceptable driving behavior.
4. The report recommends that, should the City or County of SF support state legislation authorizing ASE, that the program begin with a focus on high injury corridors, areas of chronic speeding, and areas with vulnerable populations, such as school children and seniors.
