Update on the Cap-and-Trade Affordable Housing Sustainable Communities Program

The Strategic Growth Council (SGC) anticipates releasing its Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and full application on October 2. This statewide program targets projects that facilitate the reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions by improving mobility options, increasing infill development, and protecting agricultural land from sprawl development. At least \$255 million will be available competitively for this cycle. Full program guidelines may be found at <http://sgc.ca.gov/Grant-Programs/AHSC-Program.html>. SGC will be hosting workshops around California in early October. The Sacramento area workshop will be held on October 2, at Sacramento City Hall. In addition to a general presentation, SGC offered one-on-one meetings with project applicants looking for more information.
