The Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), using the authority delegated to it by Caltrans, approves Administrative Modification #29 to the SACOG 2017-20 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). This constitutes an administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP).
