A limited number of individuals who have served on the Working Group in a previous Community Design round may be allowed to serve again.

The requirements for Working Group members are:

- participate in the entirety of four meetings
 - o Friday, June 22 orientation meeting (10:30 am. to noon)
 - o Friday, July 13, 20, and 27 working group evaluation meeting (9:00 a.m. to Noon)
- read and evaluate all funding applications twice and actively participate in all discussions
- sign confidentiality and conflict of interest waivers
 - o If a Working Group volunteer works for a consulting firm now or in the future, that firm will be prohibited from bidding on projects funded by the Community Design program in the 2018 round, and/or future stages of such funded projects.
