# 2021 State ATP changes

## 2021 ATP changes

Small infrastructure total project cost increased: \$2M

Focus shift on "engagement"

Addition of housing coordination and displacement considerations

Disadvantaged community definitions: adding Healthy Places Index; moving regional definitions to "other"

Pre- and post-project counts and greenhouse gas emissions reductions reported only on awarded projects

## 2023 ATP changes

Adding points for the project's inclusion in an active transportation or similar plan (*includes non-infrastructure projects*)

Draft and final Regional ATP Policy Framework	March - April 16, 2020
Regional ATP applications and scoring rubric released	June 1, 2020
Regional ATP applications due	September 10, 2020
Regional ATP funding recommendation announced (draft)	Late January 2021
Regional ATP funding recommendation adopted by CTC	May 2021

# Draft 2021 Regional ATP Scoring Criteria

<i>Project...</i>	<i>Points</i>
Increases walking and bicycling	0-45
Reduces pedestrian and bicyclist fatalities and injuries	0-20
Demonstrates cost effectiveness	0-10
Achieves greenhouse gas reduction goals	0-10
Supports economic prosperity	0-10
Demonstrates deliverability	0- 5
<i>Additional considerations:</i> project delivery history, benefit to disadvantaged communities	Up to 10 points
