### ***SacRT to Celebrate Expanded Evening Light Rail Service to Folsom***

**What:** The Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) is celebrating the start of expanded evening light rail service hours to Folsom. Late night service on SacRT's Gold Line will officially begin on Sunday, June 17, 2018. In anticipation of the service launch, SacRT will celebrate with a brief evening ceremony on Thursday, June 14. The service launch celebration will be followed by "Summer Stroll in Historic Folsom," a street festival that will feature aerial dancers, live music and a farmer's market. SacRT will provide extended light rail service until 10:00 p.m. to accommodate people attending the street festival.
