WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING:

CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS WORKSHOP

This interactive workshop, consisting of both breakout and group discussions, was attended by nearly 30 local agency representatives. At this event we discussed the future of collaborative operations in the region using several scenarios to guide the discussion. Working through the details of these scenarios with regional stakeholders has helped the project team to form a strong foundation upon which to increase the level of operations, coordination, and performance outcomes in the region.

ITS ARCHITECTURE WORKSHOP

Approximately 25 regional stakeholders participated in this workshop to receive an overview of ITS architecture, as well as draft roles and responsibilities and ITS projects that will form the basis of the Architecture update. This workshop included thoughtful discussions on how the ITS architecture should be used for planning and project development, as well as strategies for enacting architecture updates and required Systems Engineering analyses for individual projects. The presentation from this workshop has been posted to the project website.

In mid-September, the eight Draft Local Implementation Plans were finalized and submitted to the SACOG member agencies previously identified as those receiving their own locally focused plan. At the time of this update, SACOG and the consultant team are working with these agencies to receive their feedback and to finalize the documentation.

WHAT'S COMING UP NEXT:

■ ITS ARCHITECTURE

Within the next month the project team will complete a comprehensive draft of this important regional document. As discussed at the ITS Architecture Workshop, this document defines regional roles / responsibilities, as well as key ITS projects necessary to enable the regional to achieve its vision.

■ REGIONAL TECHNOLOGY AND MOBILITY MASTER PLAN

Also within the next month, the project team will be finalizing a comprehensive draft of this regional document. Included in this plan are the Concept of Operations and the STARNET Modernization Plan. Once finalized, this documentation will be posted to the project website for public consumption.
